Class I: Plant Container Grown

- a. Succulent
 - 1. Pot size under 6"
 - 2. Pot size 6" and over
- b. Herb
 - 1. Pot size under 6"
 - 2. Pot size 6" and over
- c. Flowering
 - 1. Pot size under 6"
 - 2. Pot size 6" and over
- d. Foliage
 - 1. Pot size under 6"
 - 2. Pot size 6" over

Class II: Perennial – single stem

Class III: Pleasing displayed collection of 3-5 annual and or perennial cut specimens

Class IV: Cut branch with berries, pods or cones – not to exceed 30" grown by exhibitor

Class V: Collection of 3-5 grasses, sedges and or rushes

Class VI: Par



*Horticulture exhibitors are expected to provide
their own glass containers for cut specimens;
clear glass bottles in proportion to sizes of specimens are best*

SPRING HORTICULTURE CLASSES

Class I: Bulbs

- a. Narcissus – division 1 - 13
- b. Any other hardy bulb (hyacinth, tulip, etc.)
- c. Miniature bulbs (scilla, iris, etc.)

Class II: Flowering Branch – not to exceed 30"

Class III: Perennial other than a bulb – one stem

Class IV: Challenge plant (distributed Fall 2021)

Class V: House Plant

- a. Flowering
 1. Pot size under 6"
 2. Pot size 6" and over
- b. Foliage
 1. Pot size under 6"
 2. Pot size 6" and over
- c. Trained plant
 1. Pot size under 6"
 2. Pot size 6" and over
