- Complete an application: The application form gathers
 information about your special interests or qualifications

 participating in small groups is the best way to get to know

- Application Review: Once the application is approved, you
 are eligible for Provisional Membership status. This time
 period allows you to get to know us and our club members to
 get to know you.
- Work with a Mentor: The Membership Committee will assign you a Mentor who will share your committee interests of choice, keep you abreast of club happenings and answer any questions you may have.
