## Class 1: Cut Specimen

- a. Flowering annual. (An annual plant is a plant surviving just for one growing season.)
- b. Flowering Dahlia – must be disbudded
- c. Flowering herbaceous Perennial, cut specimen. (A plant whose growth dies down annually but whose roots or other underground parts survive.)
- d. *Rosa in bloom*

1. Single stem
2. Spray
  - a. 3-5 different species, varieties or cultivars pleasingly displayed.

## Class 2: Single Branch Woody

Not to exceed 26" lip to tip rule.

- a. Berries.
- b. Flowering
- c. Cones (container not necessary)

Cut branch (not to exceed 26")

**Class 4: Collection of 2-5 Ferns**

**Class 5: Single Potted Plant**

- a. Flowering
  - 1. Pot 6" or smaller
  - 2. Pot over 6"
- b. Foliage
  - 1. Pot 6" or smaller
  - 2. Pot over 6"
- c. Succulent
  - 1. Pot 6" or smaller
  - 2. Pot over 6"
- d. Trained plant
  - 1. Pot 6" or smaller
  - 2. Pot over 6"

**Class 6: Autumn Bounty**

**A collection of fruits or vegetables in a container or basket not larger than 24" in any diameter. Must be grown by member. Key card required.**

**Class 7: Culinary Delight**

**Member Made preserves, relishes, pickled items, cookies, etc.  
PAR judged.**

### Class 8: PAR

**Judged against perfection rather than against other exhibits ;**

(each on its own merits). Only exhibits that do not qualify for other classes in the schedule may be shown in the Par class.

#### **Par Scoring System**

- A. 90 - 100 = First - blue ribbon
- B. 85 - 89 = Second - red ribbon
- C. 80 - 84 = Third - yellow ribbon

#### **Club Flower Show Awards**

**Best in Show** - Awarded for the best of the Firsts

**Novice Award** - Awarded to a member that has never won a First in Horticulture.

**Judges Class Commendation.**
