Class 1: Cut specimens - Bulbs, Corms

a. *Narcissus (Daffodil)* – single specimen

Scale of Points

1. Single bloom
2. Double
3. More than one bloom on stem

b. *Tulipa*

c. Other single specimen (no *Narcissus*, *Tulipa*)

Class 2: Cut specimen

a. Herbaceous Perennial Spring Bloom – cut specimen (a plant whose growth dies down annually but whose roots or other underground parts survive)

b. *Helleborus*

c. A pleasing display of 3-5 different species, varieties, or cultivars.

d. Flowering Cut specimen. Branch not to exceed 26" lip of container to tip of branch rule. Foliage must be attached.

 2. Over 6"
- d. Succulent
 1. 6" and under
 2. Over 6"

Class 4: Former Challenge

- a. Challenge plant distributed June 2024 –
Asparagus retrofractus Asparagus Fern 'Ming'
- b. Challenge bulb distributed Fall 2024

Class 5: Par Class

Judged against perfection rather than against other exhibits (each on its own merits). Only exhibits that do not qualify for other classes in the schedule may be shown in the Par Class.

Par Scoring System

- A. 90 - 100 = First - blue ribbon
- B. 85 - 89 = Second - red ribbon
- C. 80 - 84 = Third - yellow ribbon
