"A NEW LIFE...Re-use, Recycle, Repurpose"

Class I: "PHOTOGRAPHY REVISITED"

A design inspired by the club members' photographs submitted to and chosen by the Artistic committee.

To be staged on a black pedestal 40" high with a 12" square top.

Design should not exceed 30" in width (no height restriction).

To be viewed from 3 sides.

Class II: "UPCYCLED"

A design created in a repurposed dish container, incorporating sand/soil as the planting medium.

Displayed on a table, and viewed from 3 sides.

Not to exceed 24" wide.

No height restrictions.

Class III: "OUT OF THE BIN"

A design constructed of recycled items taken from the recycle bin, and plant material.

Displayed on a table and not to exceed 30" wide.

No height restrictions.

Viewed from 3 sides.

Class IV: "MYSTERY BAG"

Designers will create a repurposed, recycled, reused design incorporating botanical and non-botanical materials in a "Mystery Bag" provided by the committee.

Displayed on a table.

Class I: "WOMEN OF FASHION"

A dynamic design featuring leaf manipulation inspired by women in fashion. To be displayed on a pedestal 40" tall with a 12" square top and not to exceed 30" width: no height restriction.

Some suggestions include Donna Karan, Coco Chanel, Mary Quant, Miuccia Prada.

Class II: "WOMEN IN SPORTS"

A design inspired by well-known sports figures.

To be displayed on a table and not to exceed 30".

A few suggestions include Serena Williams- Tennis, Ko Jin-Young - Golf, Megan Rapinoe- Soccer, Simone Biles- Gymnastics.

Class III: "WOMEN IN CONSERVATION"

A design including woody branches and perennials, in a medium niche.

Design must remain within the area of the niche.

Exhibitor is responsible for lining the back, sides and floor of the niche.

Class IV: "WOMEN IN CUISINE"

A challenge class featuring women known for cuisine accomplishments.

All materials will be provided by the committee, but bring your own scissors and clippers.
